



Dusty Springfield


Acrylic mixed with oil Silver Screen On Birch Wood (16x16) 08/02/2020




Joseph Louis Debrosse


Micheline






Snoh Aalegra

The Dogons

The Dogons are a West African people, from Mali. The Dogon land is specifically in the cliffs and plateau of Bandiagara which their arrival is estimated around the 13th century, following the fall of the Malian empire. The Badiangara cliffs and plateau region is now protected by UNESCO and has been registered since 1989. Nevertheless, the ancestors of the Dogons originally came from Mande, an area in the southwest of Mali and northeast Guinea. Those who at first sight, deemed them as primitive, are baffled. Their symbiosis with the environment is expressed through cults, traditions, ceremonies, and rituals honoring the Creator (Amma), the ancestors, and the stars. Everything within their culture is of profound symbolism. Everything from their food, clothing, potteries, sculptures homes tell a story. They have been able to assemble every resource at hand, to design their place of living in a fashion that embodies cleverly their journey through existence.



The tip of the chouillier is carved with a horse's head. The Morin Khurr is also known as the horsehead fiddle and can be played like a string or a banjo. In the steppes plain fields, this instrument can be heard for miles. The Morin Khuur is an instrument of great importance for the Mongols and is a reflection of their nomadic lifestyle and their love for horses.



The Xiangqi Players - China



Depiction of 3 men from China playing their traditional chess in the outdoors during the winter. This game called Xiangqi predates the conception of China itself and was already embedded in the fabric of the region. It seems that there is some ambiguity to the meaning of the word Xiangqi. Three meaning are mostly common to the name of the game which is:

1. The Elephant Game 2. The Figure game 3. The Constellation Game

Nevertheless, it is said that Xiang is more likely to be associated with the word elephant, and Qi with the word Chess. It is not clear whether Xiangqi originated in India or is derived from the Chinese game called Liubo. Liubo being a game dated to three and a half millennia shows some similarities to the game of Xiangqi. One notable thing is that the original pieces in Liubo were made of ivory and that the elephant was an animal incorporated in the military.


From what is known right now, the origin of the Yemenite judaism is unclear. Many theories are presented, such as they may be part of the ten lost tribes, or are the descendants of the Queen of Sheba, or even the descendants of the one who were exiled from egypt. The one that seems to be pushed more consistently is that there were Jewish migrations between the 3rd century BC to the 3rd century AD, when the perfume and spice commerce was really active. It is also said that King Herod sent Jewish regiments to the Romans to assist them in their campaign to the south of Arabia. Further in time, we can observe a massive migration of yemenite jews, a few weeks following the creation of the state of Israel. So most of them migrated to Israel and just a few chose to remain in Yemen. The last few to remain in Yemen, were located in the north of the country. Most have migrated to Israel.

The Badus are a nomadic arabic people, mostly from the Arabic peninsula to the Middle East and North Africa. The tribes have planted seeds in the soils of Egypt, Israel, Iraq, Syria, Jordan and Sudan... The term Badu can also take various forms such as Bedu, Badw, Badawi, al-baiyah, or better known in it's romanized/anglicized form, as Beduin or Bedouin. In the old testament of the Bible, they are known as the people of Kedar, in the Qur'an as the A'rabs, and were called Arabaa by the Assyrians. Badus refer to the people of the desert, and are known to live in arid steppe regions. The Badus are adventure seekers. They pride themselves as being the original Arabs, and it is there nomadic lifestyle that reflects their freedom, their bond with the environment, and their spirituality.

Muddy Waters was a source of inspiration for many rock and blues legends such as The Beatles, The Rolling Stones, Jimi Hendrix, Eric Clapton, The Doors, Led Zeppelin AC/DC, and many more of our contemporary performers.



This is vivid portrait of a vegetable market in a Street of older Nazareth, Palestine. Between 1934-1937.




Maasai Woman

The Maasai people are the original people of the Nile Valley, thus speaking a Nilotic language. The Maasai are believed to have originated in North Africa. Many centuries ago they migrated and followed the Nile River upward to their current locations. Today, they can be found in the northern, central and southern Kenya, also in northern Tanzania in East Africa. Although known to be warriors in body and spirit, they traditionally had a pastoral lifestyle, such as herders. Unfortunately their way of life has been altered by the industrialized world. They are of a monotheistic faith and the name they call their creator is Ngai (pronounce Engai of Enkai). Ngai means Rain, and his spirit is said to live in "Ol Doinyo Lengai" which means "The Mountain Of God". The Massai people have High priests called "Laibon" (Laiboni in plural) who play the role of intercessors between the creator and it's creatures, and are clairvoyants for the visible and the invisible worlds. The "Laiboni" have healing powers, and are the Masters of ceremonies, rituals etc.




Journey From Bethlehem To Jerusalem
